This award celebrates the legacy of Ann Marie Ruskin and encourages child support professionals to continue NCSEA's mission of promoting and influencing child support policy and services, and to educate, connect, and inspire those who work in child support.

The award will be presented at the NCSEA 2025 Leadership Symposium, August 11-14, in Atlanta, Georgia.
